Scholarship Recognition Application

The Sierra Madre Rose Float Association is seeking applications from qualified applicants for its annual scholarship award. One scholarship totaling \$1,500 will be awarded to the most qualified applicant. To be considered for the award, an applicant must currently be a senior in high school or a freshman in college, have at minimum 3.0 GPA, and have contributed substantial service to the Sierra Madre Rose Float Association. Consideration for this award shall be based solely on the following criteria:

Service to the Sierra Madre Rose Float Association

Scholarship applicants must have been active in one or more Sierra Madre Rose Float activity such as fundraising, design, construction, decorating, sales booth worker or as a past or present float rider.

Academic Performance

Strong academic performance is expected from each applicant, and all who apply must have at least a 3.0 grade point average. Please enclose an "unofficial" transcript. An official transcript may be requested at a later date.

Community Service

Service to the community is how we keep our communities strong. All applicants should explain the role that service to their community plays in their life. We recognize that community service during the pandemic and shortly thereafter is probably very different from prior community service you have performed. Please also include any relevant info about what you have done during the last year.

Letters of Recommendation

Two letters of recommendation are required. One should address your academic achievements and one should specifically address your service to the community. Please see the "High School/College Recommendation" form and the "Service Recommendation form".
